BILL SUMMARY Permits local governmental units, including community colleges and public schoos, to enter installment contracts or lease-purchase agreements with qualified providers for the purpose of securing energy conservation improvements. Provides that energy savings must equal or exceed the amount of the contract, that the contract may extend up to ten years, and that the provider must post bond in the amount of energy savings guaranteed in the agreement.
