A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW MARTIN COUNTY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR USE BY  
THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-158.1(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Scope. – This section applies to Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Bladen, Brunswick,  
Cabarrus, Carteret, Chowan, Columbus, Currituck, Duplin, Edgecombe, Forsyth,  
Franklin, Greene, Halifax, Harnett, Haywood, Iredell, Jackson, Johnston, Lee, Macon,  
Madison, Martin, Moore, Nash, Orange, Pasquotank, Pender, Randolph, Richmond,  
Rowan, Sampson, Scotland, Stanly, Union, Wake, and Watauga Counties."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
