1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO CREATE A DRUG-FREE PUBLIC HOUSING ZONE BY PROVIDING
3 AN ENHANCED PENALTY FOR DRUG OFFENSES NEAR PUBLIC HOUSING
4 IN THE CITIES OF ASHEVILLE, EAST SPENCER, LUMBERTON, NEW BERN,
5 RALEIGH, SALISBURY, AND WASHINGTON, AND THE COUNTIES OF
6 CUMBERLAND, DUPLIN, GRAHAM, HAYWOOD, JACKSON, MADISON,
7 AND SWAIN COUNTIES.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 Section 1. G.S. 90-95(e) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

10 "(10) Any person 21 years of age or older who commits an offense under G.S.
11 90-95(a)(1) on property owned, leased, or managed by a housing
12 authority (as defined in G.S. 157-3) or within 300 feet of the boundary
13 of real property owned, leased, or managed by a housing authority shall
14 be punished as a Class E felon. For purposes of this subdivision, the
15 transfer of less than five grams of marijuana for no remuneration shall
16 not constitute a delivery in violation of G.S. 90-95(a)(1)."

1 Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Cities of Asheville, East Spencer,
2 Lumberton, New Bern, Raleigh, Salisbury, and Washington, and the Counties of
3 Cumberland, Duplin, Graham, Haywood, Jackson, Madison, and Swain.

4 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to acts
5 committed on or after that date.
