1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ENSURE THE BEST USE OF DAY CARE FUNDS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 108A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 108A-36.1. Child day care payments.

- (a) Child day care payments available under this Part shall be made by check with both the recipient and the child day care provider as payees. All payments shall be made in arrears.
- (b) When child day care payments are being made in order to enable a recipient to work, the Department of Human Resources shall periodically require documentary proof of employment."
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to payments made on or after that date.
