6	"(a) Sta	ndards The Commission must determine whether a rule meets all of the
7	following criteria:	
8	(1)	It is within the authority delegated to the agency by the General
9		Assembly.
10	(2)	It is clear and unambiguous.
11	(3)	It is reasonably necessary to fulfill a duty delegated to the agency by the
12		General Assembly. Assembly, when considered in light of the
13		cumulative effect of all rules adopted by the agency related to the
14		specific purpose for which the rule is proposed and the legislative intent
15		of the General Assembly in delegating the duty.
16	The Commission may determine if a rule submitted to it was adopted in accordance	
17	with Part 2 of this Article. The Commission must notify the agency that adopted the rule	
18	if it determines that a rule was not adopted in accordance with Part 2 of this Article and	
19	must return the rule to the agency. Entry of a rule in the North Carolina Administrative
