March 9, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF COPIES OF CERTAIN PUBLICATIONS TO THE STATE PERSONNEL COMMISSION AND TO THE OFFICE OF STATE PERSONNEL. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 7A-343.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 7A-343.1. Distribution of copies of the appellate division reports. The Administrative Officer of the Courts shall, at the State's expense distribute such number of copies of the appellate division reports to federal, State departments and agencies, and to educational institutions of instruction, as follows: Governor, Office of the 1 Lieutenant Governor, Office of the 1 Secretary of State, Department of the 2 State Auditor, Department of the 1 Treasurer, Department of the State 1 Superintendent of Public Instruction 1 Office of the Attorney General 11 State Bureau of Investigation 1 Agriculture, Department of 1 Labor, Department of 1

One copy of the Session Laws shall be furnished the head of any department of State government created in the future.

State agencies, institutions, etc., not found in or covered by this list may, upon written request from their respective department head to the Secretary of State, and upon the discretion of the Secretary of State as to need, be issued copies of the Session Laws on a permanent loan basis with the understanding that should said copies be needed they will be recalled."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
