A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE PENALTY FOR SPEEDING ON THE INTERSTATE  
HIGHWAYS IN ALAMANCE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-141 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(j3) A person who drives a motor vehicle at a speed more than the posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour but no more than 70 miles per hour on a highway that is part of the Interstate Highway System is responsible for an infraction and shall not be assessed court costs.

This subsection does not apply in posted highway work zones or to the operators of school buses.

There shall be no insurance premium surcharge under the Safe Driver Incentive Program or increase in insurance premium on account of cession to the Reinsurance Facility for a violation of this subsection."

Sec. 2. This act applies in Alamance County only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to pending speeding citations.
