A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION OF CITY LAW  
2 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHILE TRANSPORTING PERSONS IN CUSTODY  
3 WITHIN THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 15A-402(c) reads as rewritten:

7 "(c) City Officers, Outside Territory. – Law-enforcement officers of cities may  
8 arrest persons at any point which is one mile or less from the nearest point in the  
9 boundary of such city. Law enforcement officers of cities may transport a person in  
10 custody to or from any place within the State for the purpose of that person attending  
11 criminal court proceedings. While engaged in the transportation of persons for the  
12 purpose of attending criminal court proceedings, law enforcement officers of cities may  
13 arrest persons at any place within the State for offenses occurring in connection with the  
14 transportation of persons in custody."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995.
