A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE STUDY COMMISSION ON THE DEPARTMENT OF
CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 20.4(d) of Chapter 324 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"(d) The Study Commission shall make an interim report to the 1996 Regular
Session of the 1995 General Assembly by May 1, 1996, and shall submit a final written
report of its findings and recommendations to the ~~General Assembly by May 1, 1996.~~ 1997
General Assembly. All reports shall be filed with the Speaker of the House of
Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. Upon filing its final report,
the Commission shall terminate."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective April 30, 1996.
