1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE 3 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO COMPLETE THE EXPANSION OF THE DOWDY-FICKLEN STADIUM AT EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY. 4 5 Whereas, the addition of 12,460 seats at the Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium at East Carolina University will bring the seating capacity to 47,460; and 6 7 Whereas, a larger Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium will meet the demands of football fans, but it will also increase revenue, promote tourism, provide a facility for special events, and enhance the ECU football team's potential for future conference affiliation; 9 10 and 11 Whereas, State funding is needed to complete the expansion of the stadium to 12

benefit Eastern North Carolina; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to complete the expansion of the Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium at East Carolina University, provided these funds are matched on the basis of two dollars (\$2.00) of non-State funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
