A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A LEGISLATIVE
2 RESEARCH COMMISSION STUDY ON IMPROVING THE SMALL CITIES
3 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the issue of block
7 grant awards by the Small Cities Community Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

8 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may report the results of its
9 study, along with any legislative proposals and cost analyses, to the 1997 General
10 Assembly.

11 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly
12 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to fund this
13 act.

14 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
