1		A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO A	AMEND THE NURSING HOME ADVISORY COMMITTEE LAW AND
3	THE OMB	UDSMAN LAW AS IT AFFECTS NEW HANOVER COUNTY.
4	The General A	ssembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Sect	ion 1. G.S. 131E-128(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b)	(1) A community advisory committee shall be established in each
7		county which has a nursing home, including a nursing home operated
8		by a hospital licensed under Article 5 of G.S. Chapter 131E, shall
9		serve all the homes in the county, and shall work with each home in
10		the best interest of the persons residing in each home. In a county
11		which has one, two, or three nursing homes, the committee shall have five
12		members. In a county with four or more nursing homes, the committee shall
13		have additional member for each nursing home in excess of three. The
14		committee shall have one member for every 50 nursing home beds in
15		the county.
16	(2)	In each county with four or more nursing homes, the committee shall
17		establish a subcommittee of no more than five members and no fewer than

1		three <u>visiting</u> members from the committee for each nursing home in the
2		county. Each member must shall serve on at least one subcommittee.
3	(3)	Each committee shall be appointed by the board of county
4		commissioners. Of the members, a minority (not less than one-third
5		but as close to one-third as possible) must-shall be chosen from among
6		persons nominated by a majority of the chief administrators of nursing
7		homes in the county and of the governing bodies of the hospitals
8		licensed under Article 5 of G.S. Chapter 131E, which operate nursing
9		homes. If the nursing home administrators and the governing bodies of
10		the hospitals licensed under Article 5 of G.S. Chapter 131E, which
11		operate nursing homes fail to make a nomination within 45 days after
12		written notification has been sent to them by the board of county
13		commissioners requesting a nomination, these appointments may be
14		made by the board of county commissioners without nominations."
15		2. G.S. 143B-181.19 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
16	"(<u>c)</u> Noth	ing in this section precludes a county from maintaining its owr
17	Ombudsman O	ffice, paid for by the county. The County Ombudsman shall have all the
18	powers and dut	ies of the Regional Ombudsman."
19	Sec.	3. This act applies only to the County of New Hanover.
20	Sec.	4. This act is effective upon ratification.

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
