Article 11 of Chapter 18B of the General Statutes is amended by 6 7 adding a new section to read: "§ 18B-1105.1. Authorization of liquor importer/bottler permit. 8 9 The holder of a liquor importer/bottler permit may: 10 Receive spirituous liquor in closed containers into foreign trade zones at (1) the State Port facilities in Morehead City and Wilmington from ships 11 docked at the State Port facilities for the purpose of bottling, packaging, 12 or labeling. 13 Bottle, package, or label in this State spirituous liquor imported or 14 (2) received into a foreign trade zone pursuant to this section. 15 Receive spirituous liquor in closed containers into the foreign trade 16 <u>(3)</u> zones at the State Port facilities in Morehead City and Wilmington from 17 ships docked at the State Port facilities for storage, sale, shipment, and 18 transshipment to the State or a local ABC board warehouse or, subject 19
