A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 3 TECHNOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, INC. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Technological Development Authority, Inc., (TDA), the sum of three million five 6 hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of three 7 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to support 8 the continued development of the Technological Development Authority's statewide 9 entrepreneurial infrastructure. 10 Of the funds appropriated in this act, the sum of two million five hundred (b)11 thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of two million five 12 hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year shall be used to 13 establish new business incubators in areas not currently served; to enhance existing TDA-14 sponsored incubators through the establishment of equivalent standard business support 15 services for rural, as well as urban, incubators; to develop TDA incubators into statewide 16 vehicles for recruitment and location of early stage industrial development targets; and to 17 fund other administrative costs incurred by TDA. 18

19 (c) Of the funds appropriated in this act, the sum of one million dollars 20 (\$1,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000)

- 1 for the 1996-97 fiscal year shall be used for expanding TDA's current Innovation
- Research Fund to support the identification and early stage development of technological
 innovations developed in the State's research universities.
- 4 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
