A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REIMBURSE LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS FOR THE COST OF CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECKS OF PUBLIC SCHOOL PERSONNEL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of five hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$570,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$570,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year. These funds shall be used, to the extent funds are available to do so, to reimburse local school administrative units the cost of certain criminal history checks authorized by Senate Bill 223 of the 1995 General Assembly, if enacted.

These funds shall be used only for criminal history checks of public school personnel paid from State funds and applicants for public school employee positions funded from State funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
