State agencies, institutions, etc., not found in or covered by this list may, upon written 4 request from their respective department head to the Secretary of State, and upon the 5 discretion of the Secretary of State as to need, be issued copies of the Session Laws on a 6 permanent loan basis with the understanding that should said copies be needed they will 7
- 8 be recalled."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
