Referred to: Local Government and Regional Affairs April 4, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM TO REGULATE BY ORDINANCE THE POSSESSION OF MALT BEVERAGES AND UNFORTIFIED WINE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 18B-300(c) reads as rewritten: Local Ordinance. – A city or county may by ordinance regulate ordinance: "(c) Regulate or prohibit the consumption of malt beverages and unfortified (1) wine on the public streets in that city or county and on property owned or occupied by that city or county. county; Regulate or prohibit the possession of open containers of malt beverages **(2)** and unfortified wine on public streets in that city or county and on property owned or occupied by that city or county; and Regulate or prohibit the possession of malt beverages and unfortified <u>(3)</u> wine on public streets, alleys, or parking lots which are temporarily closed to regular traffic for special events." Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem. Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
