A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITIES OF WINSTON-SALEM AND WILMINGTON AND NEW HANOVER COUNTY TO REGULATE BY ORDINANCE THE POSSESSION OF MALT BEVERAGES AND UNFORTIFIED WINE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 18B-300(c) reads as rewritten:		
"(c)	Local <u>(1)</u>	Ordinance. – A city or county may by ordinance regulate ordinance: Regulate or prohibit the consumption of malt beverages and unfortified wine on the public streets in that city or county and on property owned or occupied by that city or county. county;
	<u>(2)</u>	Regulate or prohibit the possession of open containers of malt beverages and unfortified wine by pedestrians on public streets in that city or county and on property owned or occupied by that city or county; and
	<u>(3)</u>	Regulate or prohibit the possession of malt beverages and unfortified wine on public streets, alleys, or parking lots which are temporarily closed to regular traffic for special events."

- Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem, the Town of Atlantic Beach, the City of Wilmington, Town of Chapel Hill, City of Charlotte and New Hanover County.
- 4 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
