10			wine on the public streets in that city or county and on property owned
11			or occupied by that city or <del>county.</del> <u>county;</u>
12		<u>(2)</u>	Regulate or prohibit the possession of open containers of malt beverages
13			and unfortified wine by pedestrians on public streets in that city or
14			county and on property owned or occupied by that city or county; and
15		<u>(3)</u>	Regulate or prohibit the possession of malt beverages and unfortified
16			wine on public streets, alleys, or parking lots which are temporarily
17			closed to regular traffic for special events."

- Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Cities of Charlotte, Wilmington and Winston-Salem; the Towns of Atlantic Beach and Chapel Hill; and New Hanover County.
- 4 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
