2	AN ACT TO ENSURE FAIRNESS TO TEACHER ASSISTANTS IN
3	KINDERGARTEN THROUGH THIRD GRADE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 115C-12(8) reads as rewritten:
6	"(8) Power to Make Provisions for Sick Leave Leave and for Substitute
7	Teachers. – The Board shall provide for a minimum of five days per
8	school year term of sick leave with pay for all public school employees
9	in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter and shall promulgate
10	rules and regulations providing for necessary substitutes on account of
11	said-sick leaveleave and other teacher absences.
12	The pay for a substitute shall be fixed by the Board. If a teacher
13	assistant assigned to a classroom in kindergarten through third grade
14	acts as a substitute teacher for that classroom, the salary of the teacher
15	assistant for the day shall be the same as the daily salary of an entry-
16	level teacher with an 'A' certificate.
17	The Board may provide to each local school administrative unit not
18	exceeding one percent (1%) of the cost of instructional services for the
19	purpose of providing substitute teachers for those on sick leave as

- authorized by law or by regulations of the Board, but not exceeding the 1 provisions made for other State employees." 2 3
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
