15	Sec. 2. G.S. 95-85.21A is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
16	"(g) Any location operating outside the State that ships, mails, or delivers in any
17	manner devices or medical equipment to the user of the equipment in this State shall
18	comply with the provisions of G.S. 90-85.22, G.S. 90-85.24, and rules adopted by the
19	Board governing such locations."
