A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT AUTHORIZING SANITARY DISTRICTS TO PROVIDE STREETS AND
LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AND ALLOWING SMALL SANITARY
DISTRICTS TO COMPENSATE BOARD MEMBERS IN THE SAME MANNER
AS LARGE SANITARY DISTRICTS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 130A-55 is amended by adding two new subdivisions to read:
"(23) To acquire (by purchase, lease, gift, or otherwise), construct, maintain,
operate, and regulate roads and streets within the sanitary district. Not
all of these powers need be exercised.
(24) To contract for security personnel or to provide for law enforcement
within the district to the same extent that a city or town is authorized to
provide for law enforcement pursuant to Article 13 of Chapter 160A of
the General Statutes. For the purpose of this subdivision, any reference
in Article 13 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes to 'city' is to be
interpreted to include a sanitary district."
Sec. 2. G.S. 130A-55(15) reads as rewritten:

1 2	"(15) To use the income of the district, and if necessary, to levy and collect taxes upon all the taxable property within the district sufficient to pay
3	the costs of collecting and disposing of garbage, waste and other refuse,
4	and-to provide fire protection and rescue services in the districtdistrict,
5	to acquire, construct, maintain, operate, and regulate roads and streets
6	within the district, and to provide for law enforcement within the

9	Sec. 3. G.S. 130A-55(24) as enacted by this act shall expire on July 1, 1997.
10	Sec. 4. Effective July 1, 1997, G.S. 130A-55(15) as amended by this act reads
11	as rewritten:
12	"(15) To use the income of the district, and if necessary, to levy and collect
13	taxes upon all the taxable property within the district sufficient to pay
14	the costs of collecting and disposing of garbage, waste and other refuse,
15	to provide fire protection and rescue services in the district, and to
16	acquire, construct, maintain, operate, and regulate roads and streets

18	Sec. 5. G.S. 130A-56 reads as rewritten:
19	"§ 130A-56. Election of officers; board staff. <u>compensation.</u>
20	(a) Upon election, a sanitary district board shall meet and elect one of its members
21	as chairperson and another member as secretary. In sanitary districts with a population of
22	less than 15,000, each member of the board may receive a per diem compensaton and other
23	compensation as provided for members of State boards under G.S. 138-5, payable from the funds
24	of the district.
25	(b) The board may employ a elerk, stenographer <u>clerk</u> or other assistants as
26	necessary and may fix duties of and compensation for employees. A sanitary district
27	board may remove employees and fill vacancies.
28	(c) The board may, by ordinance, fix the compensation of its members in an
29 20	amount not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month, payable from the
30	funds of the district, but no increase may become effective earlier than the first meeting
31 32	of the board following the next election of board members after adoption of the ordinance. Until adoption of an ordinance under this subsection, the compensation of
32 33	members of sanitary district boards shall remain at the amount payable by law immediately prior
34	to March 25, 1985. This subsection applies only to sanitary districts with a population of 15,000
35	or over. each member of the board may receive compensation as provided for members of
36	State boards under G.S. 138-5, payable from funds of the district."
37	Sec. 6. This act is effective upon ratification.
