BILL SUMMARY:

The proposed act authorizes certain counties to adopt a local ordinance that would allow fees charged for inspecting septic tanks and systems to be billed as property taxes. If these fees are not paid, the county may place a lien on the real property described on the tax bill. The act applies to Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell and Washington.
