5	Section	on 1. It is unlawful for any person to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or
6	wild bird with a	firearm, bow and arrow, crossbow, or other deadly weapon, or to attempt
7	to hunt, take, or	kill any wild animal or wild bird, on, from, or across the right-of-way of
8	any public road	, street, or highway in Person County, or to discharge any firearm, bow
9	and arrow, cross	sbow, or other deadly weapon on, from, or across the right-of-way of any
10	public road, stre	et, or highway in Person County.
11	Sectio	on 2. This section does not apply to:
12	(1)	The use or possession of firearms in defense of persons or property;
13	(2)	Law enforcement officers or members of the armed forces acting in the
14		line of duty;
15	(3)	The use of firearms pursuant to the lawful direction of law enforcement
16		officers;
17	(4)	Public or private shooting galleries or ranges; or
18	(5)	Private landowners or lessees in possession, on their own property,
19		using their own firearms to control pests or pursuant to permits issued
20		by the Wildlife Resources Commission.

1	Section 3. For purposes of this act, in addition to the definitions contained in	
2	G.S. 113-130(5a) and (7), the terms "hunt, take, or kill"include pursuing, tracking, or	
3	being in wait for the purpose of hunting or taking any wild animal or wild bird, as well as	
4	setting out any hunting dog or dogs or recovering that dog or dogs used to find, track,	
5	pursue, hunt, or take any wild animal or wild bird.	
6	Section 4. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor. A second violation	
7	of this act within three years is a Class 2 misdemeanor.	
8	Section 5. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife	
9	Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, by officers of the Highway	

10 Patrol, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

- Section 6. This act applies only to Person County.
- 12 Section 7. This act becomes effective October 1, 1998.
