4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local
6	School Administrative Units the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1997-98
7	fiscal year and the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to
8	improve services for students with limited English proficiency. The State Board of
9	Education shall allocate these funds to local school administrative units with a high
10	percentage of students for whom English is a second language.
