2	AN ACT TO ALLOW ALL HANDICAPPED PERSONS TO USE A REGISTERED
3	SIGNATURE FACSIMILE AS A MARK OF THEIR LEGAL SIGNATURE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 22A-1 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 22A-1. Use of a signature facsimile by a visually handicapped person.
7	A visually handicapped person, as defined in G.S. 111-11G.S. 168A-3(4), may use a
8	registered signature facsimile as a proper mark of his-the person's legal signature. An
9	example of the signature facsimile shall be registered by the visually handicapped person
10	with the clerk of the superior court in the county of his domicile. where the person lives.
11	The registered signature facsimile may be revoked at any time in writing by the visually
12	handicapped person."
13	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
