April 2, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REMOVE CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MATTHEWS AND TO ADD THE PROPERTY TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The following described property is removed from the corporate limits of the Town of Matthews and is added to the corporate limits of the City of Charlotte: The Waters property, Mecklenburg County tax parcels 227-362-97 and 227-

362-98, and the Maynard property, Mecklenburg County tax parcel 227-141-08.

Section 2. This act shall have no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town of Matthews for ad valorem taxes or special assessments outstanding before the effective date of this act. Such liens may be collected or foreclosed upon after the effective date of this act as though the property was still within the corporate limits of the Town of Matthews.

Section 3. This act becomes effective June 30, 1997.

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
