1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LEE
3	COUNTY SHALL CONSIST OF SEVEN MEMBERS ELECTED AT LARGE FOR
4	FOUR-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS ON A NONPARTISAN BASIS AT THE
5	TIME OF THE GENERAL ELECTION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. (a) Effective with the 1998 election, the Board of Commissioners of
8	Lee County consists of seven members elected at large for four-year terms. In 1998 and
9	quadrennially thereafter, four commissioners shall be elected. In 2000 and quadrennially
10	thereafter, three commissioners shall be elected.
11	(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes,
12	the Board of Commissioners of Lee County shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis at the
13	time set by G.S. 163-1 for the general election in each even-numbered year as terms
14	expire. The election shall be conducted on a nonpartisan plurality basis, with the results
15	determined in accordance with G.S. 163-292. Candidates shall file notices of candidacy
16	not earlier than noon on the third Monday in June and not later than noon on the third
17	Friday in July. The names of the candidates shall be printed on the ballot without
18	reference to any party affiliations. Except as provided by this act, the election shall be
19	conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 163 of the General
20	Statutes.
