1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ENTRY ON A PERSON'S LAND BY A SURVEYOR
3	IN THE COURSE OF BUSINESS IS NOT TRESPASS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Article 22B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 14-159.15. Entry by registered land surveyor is not trespass.
8	Registered land surveyors, their employees, and agents shall have the right to enter
9	upon the lands of others and carry with them their customary equipment and vehicles and
10	perform the customary and necessary acts to perform the surveys of land. The reasonable
11	removal of undergrowth, brush, and limbs from naturally occurring plants for sight lines
12	and the marking of boundary trees and witness trees shall be considered normal and
13	necessary activities under this section. Landowners shall be held harmless to the
14	registered land surveyor and the surveyor's employees and agents for injury to persons
15	and equipment so long as that injury does not involve an otherwise unlawful or malicious
16	activity."
17	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
