A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, PLANNING,
AND DESIGN OF TWO ACADEMIC FACILITIES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
NORTH CAROLINA AT CHARLOTTE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of nineteen million eight hundred seventeen thousand three hundred dollars (\$19,817,300) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to construct a humanities building at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to plan and design a science and technology building at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
