A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF
THE NORTH CAROLINA INSTITUTE OF MEDICINE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Institute of Medicine, established by G.S. 90-470, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for operating costs of the Institute of Medicine and the general support of its efforts to study and prepare reports to the General Assembly and other State agencies on health policy issues of concern to the people of North Carolina.

Section 2. The Institute of Medicine shall report to the General Assembly by April 30, 1999, on the expenditure of these funds.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
