4	HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 130A-309.14(f) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
7	read:
8	"(3) The Department of Transportation shall, in highway construction and
9	maintenance projects, recycle yard trash and other organic solid waste
10	into compost available for agricultural and other acceptable uses. The
11	Department of Transportation may satisfy this subdivision by source
12	separating the yard trash and other organic solid waste and transporting
13	it to a solid waste area that provides and maintains separate yard trash
14	composting facilities."
15	Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
16	Transportation the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal
17	year for the costs of implementing this act.

1 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998, and applies to contracts 2 entered into on or after that date by the Department of Transportation for the construction 3 and maintenance of highways.
