## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT TO PROVIDE SPECIAL MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES

 FOR MAGISTRATES.The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
"(14a) Magistrates. - Issuable to a current North Carolina magistrate. The plate shall bear the letters 'MJ' followed by a number. The number shall indicate the district court district the magistrate serves followed by a hyphen and a number indicating the seniority of the magistrate. Magistrates from district court districts 9 and 9B shall receive plates with the number ' 9 ' as the designation for their district."
Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997.
