2	AN ACT TO CAP THE STUDENT CAPACITY OF SCHOOLS CONSTRUCTED
3	AFTER JANUARY 1, 2000.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
6	section to read:
7	"§ 115C-520.1. Student capacity of new schools limited.
8	New public schools designed after January 1, 2000, shall be subject to the following
9	maximum student capacities:
10	(1) Schools that serve all or part of kindergarten through fifth grade $-300$
11	students;
12	(2) Schools that serve all or part of grades six through $8 - 500$ students; and
13	(3) Schools that serve all or part of grades nine through $12 - 700$ students.
14	The maximum student capacity of a school that serves grades in more than one of these
15	categories shall be computed according to the percentage of students in each category it
16	serves."
17	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the new
18	public schools on which design is begun after January 1, 2000.
