A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM PROPERTY TAX MODIFIED MOTOR VEHICLES OWNED BY DISABLED VETERANS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL SPECIAL EQUIPMENT ALLOWANCES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 105-275 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(5a) A motor vehicle owned by a disabled veteran that is altered with special equipment to accommodate a service-connected disability. As used in this section, disabled veteran means a person as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(2) who is entitled to special automotive equipment for a service-connected disability, as provided in 38 U.S.C. § 3901." Section 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning

on or after July 1, 1999.
