Section 1. Section 17.1 of Chapter 23 of the 1998 Session Laws, as amended by Section 27.18(a) of Chapter 212 of the 1998 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Section 17.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Division of Motor Vehicles shall not disclose personal information in its records for purposes specified in 18 U.S.C § 2721(b)(12) prior to January 1, 2000. This section shall not expire until January 1, 2000. 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(12)."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
