A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CUMBERLAND COUNTY TO PLAN
AND DESIGN A SENIOR COMMUNITY CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for the purpose of planning and designing a community center in Cumberland County to provide services and activities for senior citizens in the county. With the funds appropriated, Cumberland County shall establish a management design team of qualified individuals in the community to consult with various State and local agencies that provide services to senior citizens to plan and design the center in an effective and efficient manner and to assure that the center is equipped to meet the needs of senior citizens without requiring them to obtain services from various sources.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
