A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO REDUCE COUNTY
APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES FOR AREA MENTAL HEALTH
AUTHORITIES FOR FUTURE FISCAL YEARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 122C-115(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) Counties shall not reduce county appropriations and expenditures for area authorities during the fiscal year for which the funds were appropriated because of the availability of State-allocated funds, fees, capitation amounts, or fund balance to the area authority."

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
