SENATE BILL 1189

AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CHINA GROVE TO
ALLOW THE TOWN TO OPERATE UNDER THE COUNCIL-MANAGER
FORM OF GOVERNMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charter of the Town of China Grove, being Chapter 309 of the Private Laws of 1903, is amended by adding a new section to read:

"Sec. 4A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Charter, the town shall operate under the council-manager form of government as provided in Part 2 of Article 7 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 19th day of June, 2000.
