2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE
3	FOR GREATER PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE DEPARTMENT'S INFORMATION
4	RESOURCES.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. There is appropriated from the Department of Insurance Fund
7	established in G.S. 58-6-25 to the Department of Insurance the sum of five hundred
8	seventy-four thousand four hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$574,469) for the 2000-2001
9	fiscal year for two computing consultants, three applications analysis programmer
10	specialists, contractual services, equipment, supplies, and office accommodations for the
11	Department. The Department shall use these positions, equipment, and contractual
12	services to automate various core insurance functions so that the Department may offer
13	public access to its databases via the Internet, including the ability to:
14	(1) Submit consumer complaints electronically and track those complaints
15	throughout the Department process;
16	(2) Access Department rules and policy forms of the Department's
17	Divisions of Life and Health and Property and Casualty; and
18	(3) Access insurance company financial information in order to help
19	consumers make an informed choice when selecting an insurance
20	company.

- 1 The Department of Insurance shall also use the funds appropriated in this act to provide
- 2 insurance companies a means by which to submit insurance rates electronically.
- 3 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
