1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO RELOCATE THE NORTH CAROLINA GOVERNMENT
3	COMPETITION COMMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
4	TO THE OFFICE OF STATE BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 143C-3(a) reads as rewritten:
7	"(a) The North Carolina Government Competition Commission is created within
8	the Department of Commerce. Office of State Budget and Management. The Commission
9	shall exercise its powers independently of the Secretary of Commerce-State Budget Officer
10	and shall be subject to the direction and supervision of the Secretary of Commerce-State
11	Budget Officer only with respect to the management functions of coordination and
12	reporting. The purpose of the Commission is to be the catalyst for the use of competition
13	to improve the delivery of State government services, to make State government more
14	effective and more efficient, and to reduce the costs of government to taxpayers."
15	Section 2. Section 15.2C(b) of S.L. 1998-212 reads as rewritten:
16	"(b) Funds appropriated in this act to the Department of Commerce Office of State
17	Budget and Management for the Competitive Government Initiative shall be used by the
18	Department to implement this section."
19	Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
