A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE LAW PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN
2 SECONDARY SUPPLIERS OF ELECTRIC SERVICE MAY FURNISH SERVICE
3 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF A CITY WITH WRITTEN CONSENT
4 FROM THE CITY, ALLOWING THE BOARD OF AN ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP
5 CORPORATION TO VOTE BY PROXY ON DECISIONS TO ENCUMBER
6 CORPORATE PROPERTY OR TO DISSOLVE THE CORPORATION, AND
7 MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE LAW REGARDING MUNICIPAL
8 ELECTRIC SERVICE.

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 Section 1. Section 6 of S.L. 1997-346 reads as rewritten:

12 "Section 6. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies only to annexations
13 or incorporations that occur on or after the effective date. ~~This act expires on the date of the~~
14 ~~adjournment sine die of the 1999 General Assembly."~~

15 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
