A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY WAYS TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF DOCUMENTS RECORDED
IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study ways to improve the quality of documents recorded in the office of the register of deeds.

Section 2. As part of its study, the Commission shall study the issues addressed in the first edition of Senate Bill 873 and the second edition of House Bill 1066, both of the 1999 General Assembly.

Section 3. The Commission may make an interim report of its recommendations regarding ways to improve the quality of documents recorded in the office of the register of deeds to the 2000 Regular Session of the 1999 General Assembly and shall make a final report to the 2001 Regular Session of the 2001 General Assembly.

Section 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
