April 14, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DIRECT A LOCAL STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A LOCAL FARMERS' MARKET IN THE TOWN OF FOUR OAKS IN JOHNSTON COUNTY AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THIS STUDY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Four Oaks the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for the costs of conducting the study under Section 2 of this act. Section 2. The governing body of the Town of Four Oaks shall appoint members to a study committee that shall study the feasibility and desirability of

establishing a local farmers' market in the Town of Four Oaks in Johnston County. This

study committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the governing body of

the Town of Four Oaks and to the General Assembly no later than May 15, 2000.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
