BILL SUMMARY: Amends GS 115C-12(8) to provide that if a teacher acts as a substitute teacher for another teacher within the school for part of an instructional day, the teacher acting as a substitute shall be paid both as a teacher and as a substitute for the portion of the day the teacher acts as a substitute.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: No data is available on the number of days or partial days that teachers act as substitutes for other teachers. Currently teachers who substitute for partial days are not reimbursed as substitutes. The requirements in this bill would represent additional state, local, and federal costs. There would also be some additional administrative expense at the local level to maintain the records for fractions of days that teachers work as substitutes.
