PROGRAM(S) AFFECTED: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act becomes effective October 1, 1999.

BILL SUMMARY: The bill makes changes to the Structural Pest Control Statutes.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

Section 9 of bill increases the license fee for structural pest control as follows:

Phase one increased from \$125 to \$150

Additional phases increased from \$50 to \$65

Subphases increased from \$10 to \$15

The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services reports that as of June 30, 1999 there are 753 phase one licenses, 629 phase two/three licenses, and zero subphase licenses. Since the fee increase becomes effective after licenses are renewed on July 1, 1999, there will be no increase in revenue for FY 1999-00. Based on prior year experience, the number of licenses is projected to grow by 5% a year over the next five years as follows:
