**BILL SUMMARY:** This bill makes technical corrections to Article 7 of Chapter 110 of the General Statutes regarding the authority of the Child Care Commission and the regulation of child care facilities. In addition, this bill repeals the sunset on enhanced program standards (i.e., the Rated License System) and the requirement that the Department and the Child Care Commission not promote or require the utilization of training materials, curriculum, or policy developed by the National Association for the Education of Young Children or the National Institute for Early Childhood Professional Development.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** These technical corrections and repeals have no cost impact to state or local governments.
