(1) Consists only of distribution and storage facilities and do	es not have
	any collection and treatment facilities;	
(2	2) Obtains all of its water from, but is not owned or operated	by, a public
	water system to which the drinking water rules apply;that	is subject to
	this Article and rules adopted pursuant to this Article;	
(3	Does not sell water to any person; and person other than as	s authorized
	by the Utilities Commission pursuant to G.S. 62-110(g); an	<u>d</u>
(4	, <u> </u>	
(b) A	provision of any charter granted to a public water system in c	onflict with
the provisions of this Article is repealed."		
SECTION 2. G.S. 130A-315(d) is repealed.		
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
