Short Title: Cigarette Tax \$1 a Pack. (Public) Representatives Michaux; Insko, Miller, and Weiss. Sponsors: Referred to: Finance. June 6, 2002 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CIGARETTE TAX FROM FIVE CENTS A PACK TO ONE DOLLAR A PACK. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten: "§ 105-113.5. Tax on cigarettes. A tax is levied on the sale or possession for sale in this State, by a distributor, of all cigarettes at the rate of two and one-half mills five cents (5¢) per individual cigarette. This tax does not apply to any of the following: (1) Sample cigarettes distributed without charge in packages containing five or fewer cigarettes. Cigarettes in a package of cigarettes given without charge by the (2) manufacturer of the cigarettes to an employee of the manufacturer who works in a factory where cigarettes are made, if the cigarettes are not taxed by the federal government."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
