A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE COMPOSITION OF THE TOWN OF ANGIER BOARD OF ALCOHOLIC CONTROL FROM THREE TO FIVE MEMBERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 1969-626 reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4. If the operation of a town liquor control store is authorized under the provisions of this Act, the mayor and governing body of the Town of Angier shall immediately appoint a town Board of Alcoholic Control to be composed of a chairman and two-four other members who shall be well known for their character, ability and business acumen. Said board shall be known and designated as "The Town of Angier Board of Alcoholic Control". The chairman of said Board shall be designated by the governing body of the town and one additional member shall serve for his first term a period of three years, and one member and one additional member shall serve for his their first term a period of two years, and the other member shall serve for a period of one year; and all terms shall begin with the date of their appointment, and after the first terms shall have expired, their successors in office shall serve for a period of three years. Their successors, or any vacancy occurring in the board, shall be named or filled by the governing board of the town. The Board of Alcoholic Control shall report monthly to the town board the status and financial condition of the Alcoholic Control Board and the books of the said Board of Alcoholic Control shall be available for inspection and examination by the members of the town board at any time."

SECTION 2. The additional members of the Town of Angier Board of Alcoholic Control added pursuant to Section 1 of this act shall be added as follows:

One member shall be added whose term will expire on November 30, 2003.

One member shall be added whose term will expire on November 30, 2004.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
